Thank you for your recent purchase of Illustrate! Enclosed please find instructions regarding the download and installation of Illustrate! as well as instructions for uninstalling the Illustrate! Demo which must be done before you can install the full version of Illustrate! purchased.

DOWNLOAD & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

If you are using Illustrate! for the first time (you did not download and install the Illustrate! Demo), please download the correct version of Illustrate! for your version of 3ds Max. Make sure you select the correct 3ds Max directory as the installer may not find it correctly.

- 3ds Max 6, 7 and 8 – install Illustrate! 5.3.msi
- 3ds Max 9 and 2008 – install Illustrate! 5.4.msi
- 3ds Max 2009 – install Illustrate! 5.5.msi
- 3ds Max 2010 & 2011 32-bit – install Illustrate 5.6 (32-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2010 & 2011 64-bit – install Illustrate 5.6 (64-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2012 32-bit – install Illustrate 5.7 (32-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2012 64-bit – install Illustrate 5.7 (64-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2013 32-bit – install Illustrate 5.8 (32-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2013 64-bit – install Illustrate 5.8 (64-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2014 64 bit – install Illustrate 5.8 (64-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2015 64 bit – install Illustrate 5.9 (64-bit).msi
- 3ds Max 2016 64 bit – install Illustrate 5.9 (64-bit).msi

NOTE: If you have previously downloaded Illustrate! or the Illustrate! demo, you must first uninstall that version before proceeding with this installation. See the uninstall instructions on the next page before proceeding with this installation. If you're not sure if you have previously installed Illustrate! or the Illustrate! Demo, go ahead and following the uninstall instructions first just to be sure.

- Launch 3ds Max.
- Click on the Illustrate option in the pull-down menus. This will bring up the rendering wizard.
- Choose Skip Wizard which places you in the Illustrate dialog box.
- From the Illustrate pull down menus, choose File/Authorize.
- Illustrate will show you an application ID.
- Send the ID (request code) and your name to authorize@digimation.com to receive your code. ***

Remember: Illustrate runs for 30 days so you will have plenty of time to get your code.

- When you receive your counter-code (authorization), simply choose File/Authorize again and enter it.





UNINSTALL INSTRUCTIONS:

If you have previously downloaded Illustrate! or the Illustrate! Demo, you must first uninstall that version before proceeding with this installation. Please follow the instructions below.

1. Open the Windows Control Panel.
2. Double-click on "Add/Remove Programs".
3. Select Illustrate! from the list.
4. Click on "Add/Remove..." to uninstall Illustrate!



5. Once the program has uninstalled you may proceed to the installation instructions below.

Locating the Tutorial Files

When you installed Illustrate! the Tutorial files are stored in a subdirectory Illustrate!/Tutorials under the Plug-ins directory. For instance, you installed Illustrate! to the **c:/3dsmax3.1** directory. Then the Tutorial files will be located at **c:/3dsmax3.1/Plug-ins/Illustrate!/Tutorial**

If you can't find the tutorial files re-install Illustrate! ensuring the **Tutorials** component is checked in the installation components.
