Reprogramming a V-Ray dongle

To use this system, you must have the latest V-Ray License Server installed. If you do not have the latest license server, please login to www.chaosgroup.com with your user name and password and download.

Windows operating system

- 1. Make sure the dongle is plugged in and the V-Ray license server is running
- 2. Open a web browser and type the following into the address bar: http://localhost:30304/goupgrade
- 3. After the "Success" page appears, save the remote context file (context.wbc) by right-clicking on the link and selecting save link as/save target as
- 4. Send the context file to us via email at sales@digimation.com

<u>Mac operating system</u>

- 1. Stop V-Ray license server if it is running you should see a V-Ray icon on your task bar. Right-click on the icon and choose "Exit". To make sure that the server is stopped, please check to see if a process named "vrlservice" is running using the Activity Monitor.app (in /Applications/Utilities/). If there is a filter selected, please change it to "All Processes" and search for "vrlsservice". If you find it, end/stop the process.
- 2. Go to /Applications/Utilities/ and start Terminal.app.wkconf
- 3. Type the following command (you may simply copy & paste it into the Terminal):

/Applications/ChaosGroup/VRLService/snow_leopard_x86/bin/vrlservice.app/Contents/MacO S/vrlservice

this will start V-Ray license server in the Terminal.

4. Now open Safari and type the following into the address bar: http://localhost:30304/goupgrade.

If it opens without errors, save the context.wbc file and then stop "vrlservice" by clicking CTRL+C in the Terminal window.
